### Respect for God's Word

*"So Ezra the priest brought the Law before the assembly, both men and women and all who could understand what they heard, on the first day of the seventh month. And he read from it facing the square before the Water Gate from early morning until midday, in the presence of the men and the women and those who could understand. And the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Law. And Ezra the scribe stood on a wooden platform that they had made for the purpose...And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people, for he was above all the people, and as he opened it all the people stood. And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God, and all the people answered, 'Amen, Amen,'...And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. Also...the Levites, helped the people to understand the Law, while the people remained in their places. They read from the book, from the Law of God, clearly, and they gave the sense, so that the people understood the reading. And Nehemiah, who was the governor, and Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, 'This day is holy to the LORD your God; do not mourn or weep.' For all the people wept as they heard the words of the Law. Then he said to them, 'Go your way. Eat the fat and drink sweet wine and send portions to anyone who has nothing ready, for this day is holy to our Lord. And do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.' So the Levites calmed all*

the people, saying, 'Be quiet, for this day is holy; do not be grieved.' **And all the people went their way to eat and drink and to send portions and to make great rejoicing, because they had understood the words that were declared to them.**"


The above passage from Nehemiah 8:2-12 gives us a clear view of how the word of God is to be received in the assembly. Read and re-read this Scripture, and then ask yourself, "How do I view the reading of God's word in the assembly? Am I being respectful while the word is read, or am I preoccupied with other matters?"

When the Scriptures are read, God speaks to the assembly. Proper respect and attention must be given so that you can answer "Amen, Amen."
