

The Mind of Christ and our Influence

We are all influenced in one way or another by those we spend time with. This happens from a very young age and can easily be observed in how children imitate their parents and older siblings. Therefore we need to pay attention to how we are influenced and how we influence others.

Paul speaks of this to the church in Philippi by reminding them that they are to appear as lights in the world - their behavior is of the utmost importance. "Do all things without grumbling or disputing; so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world, holding fast the world of life, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain" (Phil. 2:14-16 NASB). When people see our behavior as Christians they are influenced in

one way or another. Is our behavior attracting them to Christ or turning them away?

When grumbling and disputing are absent from our behavior, thankfulness and joy take their place. When the world sees us as joy filled people who love one another and put one another first, we truly do appear as lights in a dark world. I am thankful for the many ways the members in Puyallup exemplify this teaching. When Paul commended the church in Thessalonica for their behavior, he charged them to "excel still more." The church in Puyallup is a loving and joy filled family. Let's look for opportunities to "excel still more" in imitating Christ so that others will be attracted to Him through us.
