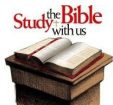

FAITHBUILDERS 2015

In the Fall of 2012, two elderships from the Puget Sound area got together for fellowship and conference. The Puyallup and Springbrook elderships had long enjoyed a camaraderie and mutual respect for the cause of Christ. We felt that the congregations in the Puget Sound area had lost fellowship and energy for working together on common efforts such as the Great Northwest Evangelism Workshop of many years ago. At this conference, we discussed what we could do to help the churches of Christ in the Northwest to reclaim the fellowship and common mission we once had.

We wanted to do something together that would help to change the atmosphere that had developed. We decided to work on organizing the churches as best we could through a workshop that could rally us all to strengthen and refocus our efforts for the kingdom.

The apostle Paul had something to say to the Ephesian church that certainly applies to the church in general today. He stated: *Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work (Ephesians 4:14-16).*

We then selected brothers from churches in the area that we felt would be supportive of such an effort, and from our first meeting, the title: **FAITHBUILDERS** was born. Originally, 8 congregations committed financially and spiritually to the effort, and the first FaithBuilders was inaugurated on July 4th 2014. We now have 12 congregations who are supporting the workshop financially.

At the first workshop, approximately 375 attended. Our goal this year is 500. We have teachers who are recognized in our brotherhood as top speakers, such as Jim McGuiggan, Dan Owen, Keith Parker, and Sam Jones. Carol Maddox is an experienced speaker for women's workshops and seminars and will challenge our women to walk in the light of God's Word. Eli Hooper is our youth speaker for Youth Challenge, as well as being a keynote speaker. I have appreciated his ability to challenge the youth of the church at the Tahoe Family Encampments for the past several years.

Inspirational singing will take place in one of the best acoustical auditoriums I have been in; Eastvold Auditorium, in the Karen Hille Phillips Performing Arts building at Pacific Lutheran University. The singing will be heavenly.

We hope you have reserved the dates of July 9-11, 2015 to attend FaithBuilders. You will be blessed! If you are unable to attend this workshop, please pray for its success to uplift the church and glorify the Lord.
