## An Abundantly Supplied Entrance

Most people truly believe they are going to go to heaven, because they have established in their own minds a spiritual "bell curve" on how one gets to heaven. God's word does not support this "logic." Jesus said, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life, and no one comes to the Father except through Me" (John 14:6).
