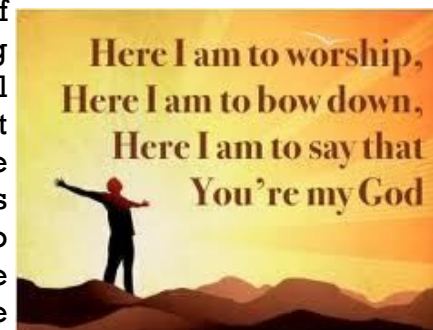

Preparing for Worship - Part II

I began a series of articles on preparing for worship several weeks ago. The first asked us to examine the issue of sin and its effect on our worship to God. This week we address the attitude we bring to worship.



Next to sin, an improper attitude while one worships is the greatest barrier to meaningful and acceptable worship. Isaiah wrote, **"In as much as these people draw near with their mouths and honor Me with their lips, but have removed their hearts far from Me..."** (29:13). Our hearts must be rightly directed. Spend time studying Matthew 23:23 and Luke 18:10-14 for other examples of improper attitudes in worship.

Our attitude is vital for our worship to be acceptable. When we come into the presence of Almighty God, we are standing on holy ground (Exodus 3:4-5). Therefore, our attitude should be one of reverence, humility, and a desire to please God and not self. Study David's attitude in Psalm 42:1-2

and 103:1-5.

When our heart is attuned to God, our attitude will be, **“I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go into the house of the LORD.’”** (Psalm 122:1).

Prepare today, and every Lord’s Day, by asking God to correct your attitude so you may truly worship Him in spirit and truth.
