

The Mind of Christ Looks at the Big Picture

There are so many things in our world that constantly compete for our attention. Everyone has a message to get across or something to sell. This can make it easy to get distracted by and focused on things that are not really important.

The church in Philippi had lost sight of what really was important and were focusing on something that was causing division in the church. Paul wrote to them about how he could boast more than anyone else in his lineage and accomplishments, but that it meant nothing to him. "But whatever things were gain to me, those things I have counted as loss for the sake of Christ. More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ

Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ" (Phil. 3:7-8, NASB). He goes on to later state that the one thing he does is press on toward the goal. When so many other things could have his attention, Paul made sure to keep his eyes on the goal of being with Christ for eternity.

Fixing our attention on the goal helps us to see better what really matters and what does not. Many of the things we focus on and boast about will end up meaning very little. What will matter is where we and our loved ones spend eternity. Let's fix our eyes on the goal and do all we can to be in heaven with Jesus and take as many others with us as possible.
