Preparing for Worship - Part III

What are your expectations when you come to worship? Do you come expecting the same old songs, the same old prayers, or another sermon that is obviously intended for someone else?



We have an "appointment" with God every first day of the week. Do you expect Him to be there when you come? You should, for **"...true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him"** (John 4:23). God is looking for (seeking) true worshipers. Does He find you expecting to find Him?

After examining ourselves and correcting our attitude, we must come to worship expecting an encounter with the Creator of the Universe - **OUR** Creator. The Father is seeking true worshipers (John 4:23). The Son is present in the sharing of the Lord's Supper (Luke 22:18). The Holy Spirit intercedes for us in our prayers (Romans 8:26).
