Preparing for Worship - Part IV

Having examined ourselves, correct our attitude, and adjusted our expectations, are we fully prepared to worship our Creator? Does the manner in which we come before Him matter, or is it an area of liberty for the Christian? What does God's word have to say?

A cursory reading of the Bible reveals how God views the manner of worship. Cain's sacrifice was rejected because he did not do right (Genesis 4:3-7). Nadab and Abihu offered "strange fire" before the Lord which He had not commanded, resulting in God's fire devouring them and they died (Leviticus 10:1-3). King Saul lost his kingdom because he offered a burnt offering he was not authorized to offer (I Samuel 13:9; Leviticus 1:1ff). King Uzziah sinned by entering into the Lords' temple to burn incense on the altar, and God struck him with leprosy the rest of his days (II Chronicles 26:16, 19-21).

Likewise, in the New Testament God has prescribed the manner of worship. During His temptation, Jesus rebuked Satan, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, "You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve." (Matthew 4:10). Jesus also told the Samaritan woman, "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth" (John 4:24). The manner has been
