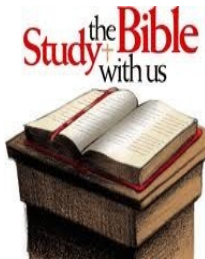

Confess to One Another

Lots of people carry burdens around that others do not see. Sometimes these burdens are things that have happened to us in the past, but sometimes they are temptations and struggles we face on an ongoing basis.

One of the most difficult commands in all of scripture is one that also can bring one of the biggest benefits. James says, "confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working" (James 5:16, ESV). While being open about our weaknesses can be difficult and scary, it helps to take the power away from temptation. When we help one another in our struggles, temptation loses much of its power. Knowing that a trusted brother or sister will hold us

accountable and pray for us helps strengthen us against the devil's temptations like nothing else can.

Satan likes to keep our sin and temptations in the dark by telling us the lie that we are all alone and that no one else will understand. God's word tells us how to deal with sin and temptation effectively, but we have to reject the lies that Satan tells, humble ourselves, and bring light into the darkness of our spiritual weakness.

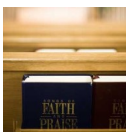
