CASA

A new ministry called **Christians Against Substance Abuse**—or **CASA**, will begin in Puyallup on Monday, September 10th at 7:00 PM. **CASA** was founded in 1988 by Buck Griffith to help **Christians find freedom from substances that enslave them.**

CASA follows a biblical application of the 12 Steps developed by Alcoholics Anonymous. However **CASA** is clearly focused on God, the wisdom of His Word, and prayer. Step 3 says, "I have made the decision to turn my will and my life over to the care of God." Step 6 says, "I became entirely ready to have God remove all my defects of character."

How can we help those who have recognized the danger of substance abuse and want to get well? A support group led by Val Blinkov, Anthony Wilson and Bob Stump will

support participants as they work through Biblical Principles for making life changes. Of course, we understand that it is Jesus who is the key to setting us free. But when Jesus gave Lazarus life in John 11, Lazarus was still bound in grave clothes. So, Jesus said to the disciples in verse 44, "Unbind him, and let him go." Even today Jesus asks His disciples to help remove the old filthy garments that sin uses to tie us up and bind us.
