

The Mind of Christ Strives for Unity

Anytime there is a group of people, conflicts of some sort are inevitable. We experience conflicts at home, at work, and sometimes even within the church. Paul wrote to the church in Philippi as there was conflict within the congregation. The effect it had on the church as a whole can be seen throughout the letter as Paul tells them again and again of the importance of their unity and their attitude toward one another. As he gets to the end of his letter he calls out the conflict at the center of the church's issues directly. "I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord. Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, help these women since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the

book of life" (Phil. 4:2-3 NTV). This conflict is one of very few times when Paul calls out individuals by name for the problems they are causing which suggests it had become serious and threatened the unity of the church. In addition to pleading with the two quarreling sisters, he also asks for assistance for them in resolving the issue.

While we do have conflicts from time to time, how we handle such situations is of the utmost importance. Jesus tells us that our unity is the catalyst to bring others to belief in Him (Jn. 17:20-21). We cannot afford to allow conflict to lead to guarreling because the success of the mission and eternity for those who we influence is at stake. Let's strive to be unified with one another in order to be successful in the mission Christ has given us. Let's strive to be unified so that more people will come to faith in Jesus.
