Be Hospitable to One Another

It is exciting each year to get to see my family when they come to visit or when we get to travel to see them. It is a blessing to get to spend time around family and reconnect, but it is also a blessing to be able to be around spiritual family on a consistent basis within the church.

The Lord designed His church to be a family of people with close relationships. We see this lived out in the first church in Jerusalem as they constantly spent time with one another and took care of one another (Acts 2:42-47). One of the major keys to this is that they spent time together and were in one another's homes regularly. One of the best ways to get to know each other and form deep and lasting relationships is to spend more than just a couple hours a week together. Paul recalls his close

relationship and communicates his love for the church in Thessalonica as he reminds them of how he and his coworkers shared their lives with the church in addition to the gospel message (1 Thess. 2:8).

God has called us to more than being acquaintances. He has called us to be family. He has called us to be close in our relationships with one another and to help each other draw near to Him. One way we do this is through obeying the command to "Be hospitable to one another without complaint" (1 Pet. 4:9, NASB).
