

The Mind of Christ is Focused


What do you spend your time thinking about? This is an incredibly important question for each of us to ask of ourselves because what consumes our thoughts determines the direction of our lives.

One of Paul's final instructions to this church was to pay attention to what they thought about. "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things" (Phil. 4:8, NIV). If the church in Philippi was to be unified, the first thing they needed to do was to change their thinking.

In order for us to be what God wants us to be, we must take control of our thoughts. Changing our thinking takes making the decision to have a godly outlook about others and to take control of what we put into our minds. Thinking like Christ does not happen by accident – it takes focus and intent.
