“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; or ministry let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.”

- Romans 12:6-8

Through the years, many have told me that they don't know or aren't sure what their “gift” or “gifts” are. Paul mentions several non-miraculous gifts in our passage above – ministering (serving), teaching, exhorting, giving, leading, and showing mercy. Most of the things we do as individual Christians and the church collectively fall under one or more of these areas.

Finding our place to work in the local congregation can only come about successfully when we “find” your gift or gifts and then put them to use in Christ’s kingdom. But sometimes, you don’t find your gift, rather it finds you.

When you involve yourself in the work, sometimes you “stumble” across something you are good at and enjoy very much. It is then that you come to the realization of where you can benefit the church – in serving, teaching, exhorting, giving, leading, and showing mercy.

The first members of the Lord’s church “... **continued steadfastly...**” (Acts 2:42) in the different areas of church work – studying God’s word, fellowshiping with one another, and worshipping the One who made it all possible – not because they *had* to, but because they *wanted* to.

Let us determine today, this week, this month, this year, to be the best we can be individually and corporately, in God’s service, bringing glory to His great and awesome name.
