God Wants Our Salvation

"For this is good and acceptable in the sight of our God and Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." - 1 Timothy 2:3-4

Paul said, "We proclaim Him, admonishing every man and teaching every man with all wisdom, so that we may present every man complete in Christ" (Colossians 1:28). We too labor to preach and teach the unsearchable riches of Christ so that each one may have hope and life in Christ.
