It Is Well with My Soul

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, even though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea." - Psalm 46:1-2


Horatio Spafford had invested heavily in real estate along the shores of Lake Michigan in Chicago, most of which were wiped out by the great fire of 1871. In November 1873, desiring rest for his family and involvement in a mission trip, he planned a trip abroad for he, his wife, and their four daughters. Last minute developments delayed his departure, but he sent his family ahead, expecting to join them a few days later. On November 22nd, his family's ship was struck by an English vessel and sank in 12 minutes. Several days later when the survivors arrived at Cardiff, Wales, Mrs. Spafford sent this message: "Saved alone."


Mr. Spafford left by ship to join his wife, and upon reaching the spot of the tragedy he penned the words to the beautiful hymn *It is Well with My Soul*, which so aptly described his own personal grief. Yet the song does not dwell on the theme of life's tragedies; rather its focus is upon the redeeming blood of Christ and the anticipation of His return.


The lesson of Mr. Spafford's example and this hymn is that we cannot dwell upon life's tragedies, whether great or small. Though events occur that overwhelming and beyond our ability to comprehend, we must have guidance from above. Even when fears arise about the future, we must remember, **"That Christ hath regarded my helpless estate, and hath shed His own blood for my soul."**
