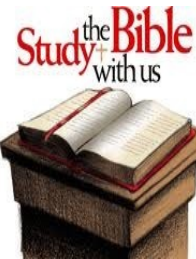

Forgive One Another

Relationships take work. This is true to some degree in all relationships, whether it is a friendship, parent-child relationship, or marriage. This is also true of our relationships with one another in the church. What complicates this is when hurts and tensions enter the equation. It is hard to make a relationship work when one or both parties have been treated poorly or hurt in some way.

For the church to be the family that God has designed, we have to learn to do the difficult work of getting past the tensions and hurts that are present in every relationship. Paul wrote that we are to "be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you" (Eph. 4:32, NASB95). Forgiving as God has forgiven is not an easy task, it means we have to be ready to let go


of the past. It means we must make a conscious decision to not hold a wrong against a brother or sister even though we may still feel hurt. God has forgiven the unforgivable in me, and He calls on me to be ready to forgive others too.


Is there someone you need to forgive? Have you offended or hurt someone? If your relationships with your brothers and sisters in Christ are not going well, then seek out reconciliation. God has designed the church to be a loving family, and that only happens when we are willing to forgive one another.
