

of the past. It means we must make a conscious decision to not hold a wrong against a brother or sister even though we may still feel hurt. God has forgiven the unforgivable in me, and He calls on me to be ready to forgive others too.

God has designed the church to be a loving family, and that only happens when we are willing to forgive one another.
