

The Mind of Christ is Generous

There is no shortage of "get rich quick" schemes going around today designed to draw people in who desire more money. These are often too good to be true, but because of greed, they still draw many people. This desire to get more and more permeates our society today, but the Bible teaches us to not set our focus on this sort of thing.

After Paul left Macedonia, the Philippian church continued to support his mission work when other churches would not. Even though the Macedonian church was poor (2 Cor. 8:1-5), they were generous because their focus was on something bigger than earthly wealth. In writing to them about their support, Paul said that what was more important than the gift itself was "the profit which increases to your

account" (Phil. 4:17 NASB). By their faithful and spiritually minded use of physical things, they were storing up treasure in heaven.

Our society values money and things above all else. This is the absolute opposite of what God's word tells us to prioritize. When we faithfully use what God has given us, Paul says that we store up treasure for the future so that we can "take hold of that which is life indeed" (1 Tim. 6:19 NASB). Are you more focused on this life or the next? Are you using the resources God has given you to build yourself up or to build the cause of Christ up?
