A Reason to Believe

“Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book: but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name.” (John 20:30-31)

Each week I ask people to commit their lives to completely to Christ.

Once a person sees the loving sacrifice of Jesus, sees who He truly is, and recognizes how His claims to be the Son of God are verified, he will have sufficient reason to believe in Jesus Christ. Though some object to these evidences, no alternative theory has ever stood to show them to be false.

There are many reasons to believe in Jesus: the fulfilled prophecies, the empty tomb, the stone taken away and governor's seal broken, the grave clothes lying there and facecloth folded, the eyewitness testimony, the faith of the apostles, the conversion of skeptical James and persecutor Saul (Paul), and the very existence of the church. All of these things point to a crucified Jesus becoming the risen Lord worthy of our praise and obedience.
