

Growing Up in Christ Takes Effort

In 2 Peter 1:3-11, we read about what it takes to grow in Christ and to be more spiritually mature. The motivation for this growth is that it leads to receiving "a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 1:11 NIV). Peter gives a list of qualities that we are to strive for in this section, and he begins by saying that we must apply diligence in order to have them. This is because it is not easy to grow in following Jesus while living in a culture that is rushing in the opposite direction, with opposing values, and vastly different priorities.

While not easy, Peter assures us that following and growing in Christ will be worth it.

We put effort into what is most important to us. The question we each have to answer is whether following Jesus is worth diligent and consistent effort? Are we willing to do what is necessary to be more like Jesus? Is His eternal kingdom worth it?
