

### **Growing in Faith Leads to Godly Morality**

It is not hard to see that the moral standards of our culture have shifted over the last several generations. The rise of the immorality that now permeates society has increased as faith in God and respect for His word have decreased.

The apostle Peter writes that as we grow in faith our moral standards also change to conform to God's standards rather than the world's. He writes that we are to add moral excellence to our faith. Hebrews 11 teaches us that true faith is marked by obedience to God, and Peter tells us that one of the first things we do as a result of our faith is to conform ourselves to His righteous moral standards (2 Pet. 1:5).

The shift in the morals of society is such that what was considered right and good just a few years ago is now questioned. The more society moves away from God's word, the more pressure there will be on Christians to compromise.

The more society moves away from God's word, the more God's people will stand out in contrast when we live out our faith. Let's strive to add moral excellence to our faith to please God and so that we can appear as lights to the world by holding fast to the word of life (Phil. 2:15-16).
