There will be a large box in the back area for your donations. Please see Bill and Leslie Staggs if you have any questions or need more information.



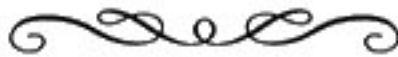
**Game Night:** Everyone is invited to join us for a game night Saturday, September 28th, 5:00 pm at the building. Please bring food to share and your favorite games.
