God's Providential Timing

It seems as if we are always waiting. We wait for our tax refunds, we wait at traffic signals, we wait for our children to grow up - wait, wait, wait! Why doesn't anything ever happen when we want it to?

David asked God in Psalm 13:1, "**How long, O LORD? Will You forget me forever?**" We don't know how long David had been waiting, but it would appear that he felt it had been long enough. His enemy was "exalted" (v. 2) and he feared his enemies "prevailing" (v. 3).

God's timing is always perfect. ALWAYS. Consider the Edomites and their oppression of the children of Jacob. God pronounced judgment over them through the prophet Obadiah around 845-841 BC. This judgment was not fully realized for almost 900 years! Yet it was realized perfectly in God's time.

Perhaps you also have an enemy who is "prevailing" over you, and you, like David, wonder, "**How long, O LORD?**" That enemy might be a neighbor, a disease, a circumstance with your job, a relationship, or an addiction. And you ask, "**Will You forget me forever?**"

Take heart, and be of good cheer, my brothers and sisters! Peter wrote, "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness" (II Peter 3:9a).
