Taking a Stand

There's an older song that says, "If you don't stand for something, you'll fall for anything." While not book, chapter, and verse, this perspective carries true biblical principles. The Bible instructs us on things for which we should stand, and things against which we should stand. Consider:

- Stand in the grace of God (Romans 5:2; I Peter 5:12)
- Stand firm and resolved in the faith (I Corinthians 16:13)
- Stand assured in the gospel (I Corinthians 15:1)
- Stand with and for truth and righteousness (Ephesians 6:14)
- Stand mature and complete in the will of God (Colossians 4:12)
- Stand in fear and awe of God (Psalm 33:8)
- Stand in awe of God's Word (Psalm 119:161)

- Stand for Christian liberty and against the yoke of slavery (Galatians 5:1)
- Stand against the wiles (schemes, plotting) of the Devil (Ephesians 6:11)

Simple to say as they are, they are much more difficult to practice day-to-day. Whether or not you stand for, with, or against these things as God's Word directs, there is a time when you will have no choice but to stand.

“For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ...that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.” - Romans 14:10; II Corinthians 5:10

Let us choose to stand with God, lest we be found standing against Him.
