Growing Faith Leads to Self-Control

"Follow your heart" is a common message in our world today in a culture that is increasingly driven by emotionalism. We are told that most anything we choose to believe or do is OK as long as it feels right. Nothing is off-limits except telling someone that a certain behavior or belief is not right.

This cultural message is opposed to God's word which has definite moral and behavioral standards. 2 Peter 1:5-6 tells us that as we grow in our faith and in our knowledge of God's word that it will lead to self-control. This means controlling our emotions, thoughts, words, and actions in the interest of imitating the lifestyle of Jesus (1 Jn. 2:6). Self-control means restraining our impulses and being willing to say "no" to things we may want but know to be

wrong. We do this because of our trust in Jesus and understanding of His standards.

Being self-controlled is not always easy. Many times it means preparing ourselves to avoid what is wrong and do what is right. After giving in to temptation we may say, "I didn't mean to." While we do not mean to sin, we also need to prepare not to. The devil is relentless in his scheming against us. Are you preparing yourself to resist his attacks?
