### Are You Glad?

**"I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go into the house of the LORD.'"**

**Psalm 122:1**

David's family had been prohibited from going to the tabernacle for ten generations as a result of the sin of Judah with Tamar (Gen. 38; Deuteronomy 23:2). David was the first to return, and he was overjoyed! He knew what he and his family had been missing.

As we look to the first day of the week, do we look forward with eagerness? Often we look to Hebrews 10:24-25 to teach the importance of being in the assembly, and rightly so. However, the focus of the text is directed toward encouraging and exhorting one another which, by implication, is not possible if you are not in contact with one another or are not present during the assembly. Look at

the second part of verse 25, **“...but exhorting one another, and so much more as you see the Day approaching.”**

There has been some debate as the meaning of the word “day” in the text. Some have taken this to refer to the Second Coming of Christ, and they may be correct. Others have pointed out that this is the “day” of the assembly (the Lord’s Day). While both could be true, I believe the context shows the second to be the better interpretation. As we look forward to the “day” (the first day of the week), we are to consider one another, not forsaking the assembly, but looking forward with eager anticipation to meeting for the purpose of worshipping God.

Back to the original question: are you glad when you see the day approaching for the assembling of ourselves together? Are you excited to come into the presence of the Creator of the Universe with songs, prayers, and remembrance, with thanksgiving? We should be rejoicing in the privilege God has given us through the blood of His only begotten Son - the privilege of access to the throne of God the Father (Hebrews 10:19-20).

Let us never take for granted the awesome opportunity given us each week. Remember, we could have been denied this for ten generations.
