John, the apostle of Love, said it this way in verse 6, "Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did." That, brothers and sisters, identifies Jesus as our key example in life.

Yes, we see a problem and feel bad about it. We recognize a need and we talk about it with others. Sometimes we even read books about it. But often we fall short of doing anything. We might confuse the heart of compassion that requires a response with the feeling of sympathy that does nothing. But that's not compassion. It's not mercy. It's not following the example of Christ. Sympathy remains only sympathy until we do something about it. Then it becomes an act of compassion: an appropriate response to the call of need in this world. Please don't misunderstand me. I'm not saying that we earn our salvation. We are saved by the grace of God, or we aren't saved at all. But Jesus himself said that a tree which bears no fruit is cut down (Luke 3:9). He wasn't talking about literal trees. He was talking about His disciples. Let's Be the Tree that bears fruit.
