There doesn't seem to be much peace in our world today. The news in the last few days has been speaking about the new war that is breaking out in the Middle East. In Eastern Europe we have been hearing about war between Ukraine and Russia for the past couple of years. In all of these there is concern about how they might escalate or what our own involvement may end up being.

The Bible tells us that Jesus is the Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6). This can be difficult to grasp in light of what is going on in the world unless we understand the type of peace that Jesus came to bring.
