God's Shepherds

"Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you."

Hebrews 13:17

The relationship between elders (pastors, shepherds, overseers, bishops) and members of the body of Christ (saints, Christians, sheep, disciples, believers) is one which should be mutually beneficial according to this verse. The sheep are to submit and the shepherds are to watch. Our submission is to be in such a way as not to cause grief but joy. Their watchfulness is to be in such a way that our souls are protected.

Peter exhorts elders as a fellow elder and witness of Christ (I Peter 5:1-4). His concern is for the elders to tend and feed (shepherd) the flock. In order for them to be effective as shepherds, they must do three things:

1. They must know the sheep. In John 10, Jesus refers to Himself as the "good shepherd." He is the good shepherd because He "gives His life for the sheep," and He knows and is known by His sheep (vv. 11, 14).

2. They must provide for the sheep. In Psalm 23, we see the LORD as a shepherd who provides all the necessities

for the sheep: green pastures, still waters, paths of righteousness, comfort, companionship, and protection.


3. They must protect the sheep. As we have seen in Hebrews 13:17, they are to watch out for the souls of those they oversee.


Let us all give diligence to create an environment of joy for those who lead. An atmosphere of grief is unprofitable for you personally and for the church collectively. Likewise, may our elders be watchful, seeking to provide a biblical environment for spiritual and numerical growth for the church in Puyallup. May they be men immersed in prayer and God's word on our behalf, as well as their own.


