A New Preacher

By now you are likely aware that Mark Jamieson from Franklin, Kentucky will be our full-time preacher here at Puyallup. At this point we anticipate his arrival in mid-January 2016. He and his wife, Suzy, are excited to begin working with us here and we are likewise excited about their being here with us. While some work remains in the logistics of getting them here, we are committed to making this work and we thank all of you for your support and help in this effort.

This is the end result of several months of prayer, phone calls, emails, discussions and your input. We want to thank everyone for your patience and input throughout this process. Of all the surveys, comments and other input, there were none who objected to Mark. While there are a few legitimate concerns and questions, which we have been answering as needed, none of them have been serious enough to prevent Mark from coming to work with us.

As for Gene, he chose to remove his name from consideration as the full-time preacher. After listening to Mark, meeting with him and seeing how he interacted with everyone, Gene could see that Mark is the better person for this job. Mark's experiences, training and passion for the lost will be a great help to this congregation, above what Gene is capable of at this time. Gene has a great love for this congregation and wants what is best for the congregation. To that end, he is offering his services as full time, unpaid elder for 12 months. His skills and passion can best be used to help the


congregation in this capacity. At the end of a year, we can evaluate if he is effective in helping us grow in that role. If so, he would like to be compensated to some degree to continue to work as an elder. If not, he will seek other employment to provide for his family until he retires.

Ephesians 4:11-13 reminds us that “God gave some to be ... pastors and teachers to prepare God’s people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature.” There are three ways that Gene can help achieve this goal. First, he will work with the “My Greater Purpose” effort begun this past spring as a way to help people identify and utilize their unique blend of giftedness, talents, experiences and passion for the Lord. Second, is in helping new members to find their place in the body and grow in their service to the Lord. Third, is in helping to develop the leadership skills of our younger men. Working with Mark, the elders, the deacons and all of you, we anticipate spiritual growth for every member of this congregation. May the Lord bless our efforts to serve Him!
