"Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful." – John 14:27

We stood by her bedside and watched with apprehension and sorrow. The hospice nurse had come to give her comfort. She was in bed but sitting up and leaning against the wall, so she could breathe.
