God Can Use You – Even if You Feel Incapable

"I can't" is a common saying when we ask one of our children to do something they think is difficult or that they do not want to do. Often these tasks are either not too difficult or plans have already been made for them to receive the help they need to do what they are asked. They still often persist with "I can't" until they are convinced otherwise in some way.

God gave Moses a big job when He told him to go back to Egypt to lead the Israelites. Moses knew it would be a hard job, and effectively told God, "I can't." In Exodus 3 and 4 Moses offered God a string of excuses as to why he was not the right man for the job or why he was incapable of the task. Each

objection was answered with the explanation that it wasn't about Moses' ability but about God's ability to work through him. Moses was incapable of leading the Israelites himself, but God was more than capable of leading them through Moses.

Sometimes we may feel incapable of being what God wants us to be. He calls us to take part in His mission, to build each other up, and love one another. He calls us to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. If God used Moses, who could not speak well, to lead a nation, how might He use you for His purpose?
