## Different, Not Lesser Abilities

*"If the foot should say, 'Because I am not a hand, I am not of the body,' is it therefore not of the body? And if the ear should say, 'Because I am not an eye, I am not of the body,' is it therefore not of the body?" - I Corinthians 12:15-16*

It is a shame to see Christians not do anything because they can't do it as well as someone else. They have a "Spiritual Inferiority Complex."

God never asked for us to all do the same thing with the same abilities - He told us to do that for which we have the capability. Verse 18 of our text tells us God Himself set the members in the body (Christ's church) just as He pleased. Your station in the church is a direct result of where God wants your abilities used.

In the parable of the talents, the one talent servant

was not condemned because he was a one talent servant. Rather, he was condemned for not using the one talent he had (Matthew 25:14-30). Jesus is sending us the same message – use what you have been given, and use it to the glory of God.

The problem is not a new one. Paul was dealing with it in the first century with the Christians at Corinth. Jealousy, inferiority, pride – all the result of not being able to do what another could, or showing off because one could do what another could not.

May we seek to do what God desires, and may He and He alone receive the glory.

Come, let us learn and grow together.
