God Can Use You Even If You Lack Confidence

Have you ever been given a task that feels overwhelming? Moving out of your parents' house as a young adult, starting a new career path, or even beginning a difficult course in college can all seem overwhelming. At times we have all felt overwhelmed by something we had to do and had no choice but to press on.

Moses fled in fear from Egypt after it was discovered that he killed an Egyptian. He spent 40 years in the wilderness in Midian, and then God told him to go back. Moses was given the task of leading a nation of slaves to freedom. He felt overwhelmed with what he was called to do, and he offered a number of excuses for why he should not go. "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the sons of Israel out of Egypt?" "What if they will not believe me or listen to what I say?" "I am slow of speech

and slow of tongue" (Ex. 3:11; 4:1, 10, NASB). Moses offered excuse after excuse. God did not accept any of the excuses. God reassured Moses not of his own ability to lead, but of God's power to work through him.

God has given us an overwhelming mission. Share the soul saving message of Jesus with all of humanity. When we consider the enormity of the task and the eternal implications, we can easily find ourselves making the same kind of excuses that Moses made. "Why me?" "What if no one listens?" "I'm not good at explaining things like this." Just as God promised to be with Moses as the true power to lead the Israelites, Jesus promises to be with us as we carry out His mission. (Matt. 28:20) The power behind our work lies in the message we share and our God who sends us.
