## Guyana 2020

Guyana continues to be ripe for harvest in the Lord's vineyard. This past trip went exceptionally well, and concrete plans were made for the next medical/evangelistic mission trip in the spring.

We have a team of 12-13 medical persons and assistants for the trip slated for May 16-23, 2020. On this trip, we will be working in two villages: Kwatamang (Benahill) and Yupukari. As in the past, we will be holding the medical clinics during the day and having a gospel meeting/revival in the evenings. All of the activities will be conducted with the cooperation of the local church.

The needs include:

- ◆ Toothbrushes
- ◆ Toothpaste (travel or 2-3oz)
- ◆ Travel shampoo (no conditioner)
- ◆ Travel soap
- ◆ Reading glasses (all powers needed)

We will be collecting these over the next 6 months in hopes of having more than enough for the folks we will see. Thank you in advance for all your efforts for the very worthwhile work.
