

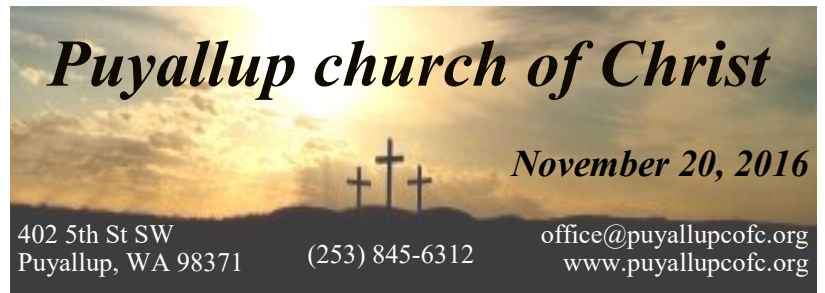

Fussing and Fighting Over Words, Pt. 1

“How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity.” – Psalm 133:1

Unity is good, and division is bad. We learn this from Jesus' prayer. The Lord prayed for His disciples, "My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in Me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as You are in Me and I am in You. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that You have sent Me. I have given them the glory that You gave Me, that they may be one as we are one; I in them and You in Me. May they be brought to complete unity..." (John 17:20-23). Jesus prayed for His followers to be one. He wants us to be on the same page and on the same team. Jesus wants us, as the apostle Paul wrote, to "agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought" (1 Corinthians 1:10).

Meeting

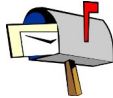
