



Wednesday Night Schedule: Beginning December 1st, we will be starting back up with our singing nights (no Bible classes) on the first Wednesday of every month.




**Prayer Meeting:** The next monthly prayer meeting will be Friday, December 3rd, 6:00 pm at the church building. More information will be
