

### Why Read the Bible?

When told to do something, human nature often drives us to question why. In school I used to question why I needed to do certain assignments. We ask what is the purpose or value of what people tell us we need to do.

In the church we emphasize reading the Bible. We read it when we come together and encourage everyone to read it on their own too. The value of reading the Bible cannot be overstated, but we do not read simply for the sake of reading. Spending time in the Bible helps to keep us away from sin. Ps. 119:11 says "I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you" (NIV). The Bible is how we come to know Jesus. The apostle Paul states that when we read what he wrote we can understand his

insight into the mystery of Christ (Eph. 3:4). If we want to know about Jesus and conform ourselves to His standards, there is no substitute for spending time in the Bible.
