What an amazing year our Father has given to us. We pray that 2018 would grant that we glory in understanding and knowing the Lord!



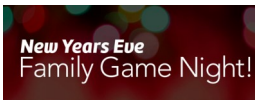
